- Step4** Check or modify abstract at **My page**

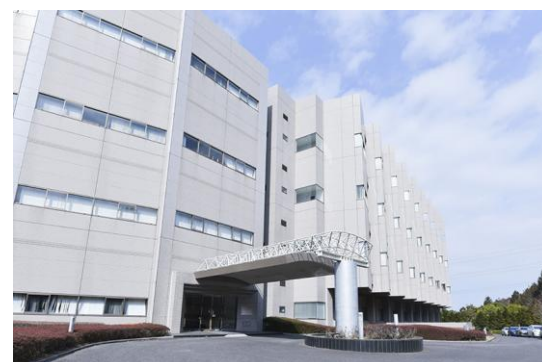
Student Forum

Kazusa DNA Research Institute was founded in 1994 and inaugurated its activity as the world's first institute specialized in DNA-related research.



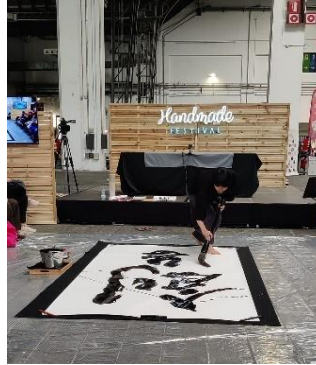
